### **Educational Classes**

#### Course #1 Estimating & Job Costing for Profit 2 hours 2 credits

With over 45 years of experience, this course presenter will share important information related to estimating and job costing. An accurate estimate is essential to good business and ensuring customer satisfaction. Builders will learn the different types of estimates, common estimate mistakes, change orders, calculating profit, and more.

#### Course #2 The Health & Wellness of Jobsite Safety 1 hour 1 credit
