Educational Classes

Course #1 Estimating & Job Costing for Profit **2 hours** **2 credits**

With over 45 years of experience, this course presenter will share important information related to estimating and job costing. An accurate estimate is essential to good business and ensuring customer satisfaction. Builders will learn the different types of estimates, common estimate mistakes, change orders, calculating profit, and more.

Course #2 The Health & Wellness of Jobsite Safety **1 hour** **1 credit**

This course will cover many health and wellness topics surrounding jobsite safety - Working in the heat, mental health, CPR-Stop the Bleed, and the prevalence of drug/alcohol abuse. Mental and physical health do have an impact on the success of a jobsite, employee, employer, and business as a whole.

Course #3 Residential Infiltration and Air Sealing **1.5 hours** **1 credit**

This course will cover the build science and building code requirements as they pertain to proper air sealing of buildings and homes. It highlights the common areas of air leakage within a structure and how to mitigate or minimize that leakage, and touches on the lesser-known areas of concern.
